



Travel Essentials



- Bring enough masks for each day on tour

- ATMs are the best way to get money
- Don't bring traveler's checks
- Notify your bank or credit card company that you'll be abroad
- We are responsible for tipping, on-tour testing and spending money
- Share any dietary restrictions or health concerns after this meeting

Entry Requirements

- Passport Books are required for all travelers.
- EF recommends that passports are valid for
 6 months after tour
- Non-U.S. citizens may require additional documentation or visas
- Please email me a color copy of your passport
- As a reminder passport cards are not accepted!

- Carry a color copy of your passport with you,
 and leave one at home
- Travelers should always carry their
 completed CDC vaccine card with them
- Carry physical/virtual copies of your COVID-19 test results


ALL travelers (even those fully vaccinated) will take a COVID-19 test on last day of tour in the early morning

Safety



Emergency Contacts: Due 7 days prior to tour

- EF will use the emergency contact list if they need to communicate any information while we're on tour.
- Make sure to fill out Emergency Contact details on your personal website by 7 days prior to your tour

Health and Medical Details: Due to me after the meeting

Please fill out the Health and Medical profile and bring it with you to our next meeting.

My Rules

- Always be on time!
- Stay with your assigned group at all times. You will have to be in a group with someone that has an international data plan.

Your go-to for information about how to reach the local equivalent of 911 while abroad.



Important Reminders



- All travelers must be fully vaccinated and boosted.
- ✓ Please sign off on your COVID-19 Safe Traveler agreement on your EF traveler website, you cannot travel without this
- ✓ I will share more information (cost and frequency) of any on tour COVID-19 testing we may need to do as a group.
- Travelers should have \$250 budgeted for these tests



- ALL travelers will take a COVID-19 test in order to return home, as required by the CDC
- Login to your EF account and review your emergency contact, it should be someone NOT on tour with you!
- Adult travelers, 20 years and older, please complete your background checks!
- ✓ If you test positive before our tour, please contact EFs Traveler Support at 800-665-5364



- Practice packing, and carrying your luggage around
- Make sure you have plug adapters
- Notify your bank, and phone company of your trip
- Cards are widely accepted, but if you're exchanging cash do so before the trip!
- Mark your calendars, we're meeting at Buckhorn High School at 7:40am, and leaving at 8:00am
